Dear Mr. President:


As you prepare the Fiscal Year 2017 budget, we respectfully request the inclusion of funding for the Flood Risk Management project in Cedar Rapids, Iowa. Congress authorized this project in the Water Resources Reform and Development Act of 2014 (WRRDA) and it has yet to receiving federal funding.

In June 2008, Cedar Rapids was devastated by flood waters, resulting in an estimated \$2.4 billion of destruction—destroying or damaging thousands of residential and commercial properties, along with important local government buildings such as the police station, courthouse, and City Hall. Following the devastation, plans were initiated to construct levees, floodwalls, and closure structures on the banks of the Cedar River.

Unfortunately, to date, the project has not been appropriated any federal funds or included in a Presidential budget and therefore, leaves a major Iowa city susceptible to future devastation. Congress has validated this project by specifically authorizing it into law and if the project does not receive funds quickly, it could be de-authorized. While we recognize the number of worthy projects and the limited availability of funding for all of them, this project is of the utmost importance as we work to prevent a similar catastrophe in the future and protect the lives and property of Iowans.
